DECOLUTION NO

A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an amendment to a Local Public Agency agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, for the Riverview Road over Furnace Run Replacement Project, in Council District 3, for an estimated total construction cost not to exceed \$1,586,000.00, to now state that the Department of Transportation will provide County Engineer's Association of Ohio Local Bridge Program funds of up to \$1,568.000.00 to cover up to 100% of the project costs, with said funds consisting of 80% federal funds up to an amount of \$1,268,800.00 to cover 80% of the project costs and toll revenue funds of up to an amount of \$317,200.00 to cover 20% of the costs of the project, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2019-111, which authorized the County Executive to execute a Local Public Agency ("LPA") agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation ("ODOT"), for the Riverview Road Over Furnace Run Replacement Project, located in Cuyahoga Falls (the "Project"), in Council District 3, for an estimated total construction cost not to exceed \$1,586,000.00, with the Department of Transportation providing County Engineer's Association of Ohio Local Bridge Program funds of up to \$1,499,120.00 to cover up to 80% of the project costs, with the County Engineer being responsible for the balance of the Project costs, and

WHEREAS, the County Executive executed said LPA; and

WHEREAS, ODOT and the County Engineer wish to enter into an amendment to the LPA agreement for the Project to now state that ODOT will provide County Engineer's Association of Ohio Local Bridge Program funds of up to \$1,568.000.00 to cover up to 100% of the project costs, with said funds consisting of up to an amount of \$1,268,800.00 to cover 80% of the project costs and toll revenue funds of up to an amount of \$317,200.00 to cover 20% of the costs of the Project; and

WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03(c) and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as Article II, Section 2.03(5) of the County of Summit Charter allow execution of such LPA agreements, subject to the approval of this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined, by reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned amendment to the LPA agreement with ODOT;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to a Local Public Agency ("LPA") agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation ("ODOT"), for the Riverview Road Bridge Replacement Project, Project Identification Number 105067 (the "Project") located in Council District 3, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said amendment to the LPA agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof by the County Executive. Upon federal authorization from ODOT, the County may commence the administration of the Project, with the award of the Project subject to applicable Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, said Ordinances requiring authorization of such an award by the Board of Control and/or County Council.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately completes a prerequisite to accept funds needed for safe and convenient travel within the County.

SECTION 3
