A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to apply for Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality grant funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study and the State of Ohio Department of Transportation to improve the Valley View Road and Chaffee Road intersection located in Sagamore Hills Township and the Valley View Road and Olde Eight Road intersection located in Northfield Center Township, in Council District 1, with the County's share to be at least 20% of the eligible costs, for the Engineer and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has set aside money for Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality ("CMAQ") projects through the State of Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") and programmed through the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study ("AMATS"); and

WHEREAS, Local Public Agencies ("LPAs") can apply for these monies and be selected for funding by the Ohio Association of Regional Councils ("OARC") who has been charged with the management of the statewide CMAQ program by ODOT; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has determined that the improvement of the Valley View Road and Chaffee Road intersection located in Sagamore Hills Township and the Valley View Road and Olde Eight Road intersection located in Northfield Center Township, both in Council District 1, meet federal project criteria and guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the federal programs will provide up to 80% of the construction and rightof-way costs for the two aforementioned intersection improvements; and

WHEREAS, the construction and right-of-way costs for the aforementioned Valley View Road and Chaffee Road intersection improvement are estimated to be \$815,000.00, and the construction and right-of-way costs for the aforementioned Valley View and Olde Eight Road intersection improvement are estimated to be \$325,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer wishes to submit two grant applications for CMAQ funds administered and programmed by AMATS and ODOT for the improvements of the Valley View Road and Chaffee Road intersection and the Valley View Road and Olde Eight Road intersection; and

WHEREAS, if requested funds are granted, the County shall be responsible for at least 20% of the eligible CMAQ costs; and

WHEREAS, the improvements of the Valley View Road and Chaffee Road intersection and the Valley View Road and Olde Eight Road are important to Summit County because they would decrease congestion and enhance safety at both locations; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to apply for CMAQ funds administered and programmed by AMATS and ODOT for the improvement of the Valley View Road and Chaffee Road intersection located in Sagamore Hills Township and the improvement of the Valley View Road and Olde Eight Road intersection located in Northfield Center Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality ("CMAQ") funds administered and programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study ("AMATS") and the State of Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") for the improvements of the Valley View Road and Chaffee Road intersection located in Sagamore Hills Township and Valley View Road and Olde Eight Road intersection located in Northfield Center Township, in Council District 1, with the County's share to be at least 20% of the eligible costs .

SECTION 2

The County of Summit acknowledges and understands the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines" and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local share is required to match federal funds.

SECTION 3

The Clerk of Council is instructed to provide two certified copies of this Resolution to the County Engineer, for submission to AMATS as part of the funding applications.

SECTION 4

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reasons that it will immediately allow the County to obtain grants for safety and congestion improvements in Sagamore Hills Township and Northfield Center Township.

SECTION 5

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
