A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into a right-of-way license agreement with Cuyahoga Valley National Park for use of County of Summit right-of-way on Riverview Road, located in Boston Township, in Council District 1, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga Valley National Park has applied to the County of Summit to utilize a portion of the County's road right-of-way of Riverview Road to develop and build a parking area in support of a Visitor Center near the corner of W. Boston Mills Road and Riverview Road in Boston Township; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has determined granting use of the County's right-ofway on Riverview Road will not negatively impact the County's ability to maintain Riverview Road; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to enter into a right-of-way license agreement with Cuyahoga Valley National Park for permanent use of County right-of-way on Riverview Road;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a license agreement with Cuyahoga Valley National Park to utilize right-of-way on Riverview Road to develop and build a parking lot area near the corner of W. Boston Mills Road and Riverview Road. The final agreement will be substantially in the form of the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately allow the Executive to execute said agreement and allow Cuyahoga Valley National Park to proceed with their efforts to construct a Visitor's Center.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
