- (2) To review the models and best practices of other Ohio counties and municipalities for stormwater management;
- (3) To review legal and administrative issues concerning stormwater management by the County;
- (4) To hire a consultant, subject to the approval of the Board of Control and County Council, to advise the Committee and to assist it in the preparation of a report;
- (5) To prepare a report for review by County Council by the end of calendar year 2020 that advises the best methods to create a County stormwater management program designed to drain 300 acres or more, and that includes the following elements:
  - (a) Member communities, which, at a minimum, shall include the communities subject to the jurisdiction for stormwater purposes of the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District, and at a maximum, all of the communities in Summit County;
  - (b) A proposed stormwater management code that includes essential elements of a regional stormwater plan;
  - (c) A proposed permanent, adequate, and dedicated funding stream, sufficient to support a qualified staff to carry out the program and a capital improvement and maintenance program with acceptable turnaround times on projects;
  - (d) A proposed stormwater master plan for all watersheds in the County, or, in the alternative a proposal to develop a stormwater master plan that would include:
    - i. Uniform standards to identify and define the stormwater management system of each community under the jurisdiction of the County;
    - ii. Performance of condition assessments in each community under the jurisdiction of the County;
    - iii. Development of hydraulic models to identify and prioritize maintenance and construction projects;
  - (e) Proposed guidance on construction projects for stormwater maintenance; said construction projects being;
    - i. Projects that address current flooding, erosion, and water quality problems and minimize new problems;
    - ii. Projects that focus on solving problems as close to their source as possible without negatively affecting downstream communities:
  - (f) Proposed inspection and maintenance activities along the stormwater systems within the jurisdiction of the County, which

- are selected based upon established processes for community input and are responsive to community and resident concern;
- (g) Proposed policies and practices that support and facilitate regional/watershed based coordination, NPDES Phase II compliance and public education and outreach efforts;
- (h) Proposed policies and practices to collaborate with the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District and the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District on maintenance and construction projects;
- (6) Any other powers granted by County Council.

#### **SECTION 3**

The membership of the County of Summit Stormwater Management Committee shall consist of the following members, which shall be appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by this Council:

## Membership.

- (1) A member of County Council, or their designee;
- (2) The County Engineer, or their designee;
- (3) The County Executive, or their designee;
- (4) A representative of a township within Summit County;
- (5) A representative of a municipality within Summit County; and
- (6) Two representatives with extensive knowledge of stormwater management.

### **SECTION 4**

Following the appointment and confirmation of its members, the task Force will deliberate for a period ending December 31, 2020, and shall make a full written report to County Council and the County Executive setting forth its recommendations no later than December 31, 2020.

#### **SECTION 5**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose to provide a stormwater management committee to recommend the best methods for stormwater management on a countywide basis in Summit County.

#### **SECTION 6**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by the law
