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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**  
8 **Rigaku Analytical Devices for a raman spectroscopy meter for the Mahoning County Type**  
9 **II Hazmat Team, in an amount not to exceed \$56,335.00, for the Executive's Department of**  
10 **Law and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety, Emergency Management Agency**  
11 **and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 19, 2019, awarded a purchase  
14 contract with Rigaku Analytical Devices for a raman spectroscopy meter for the Mahoning  
15 County Type II Hazmat Team, in an amount not to exceed \$56,335.00, subject to confirmation  
16 by County Council; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
19 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Rigaku Analytical Devices is necessary and in  
20 the best interest of the County of Summit;

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22 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
23 of Ohio, that:

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25 SECTION 1

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27 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Rigaku Analytical  
28 Devices for a raman spectroscopy meter for the Mahoning County Type II Hazmat Team, in an  
29 amount not to exceed \$56,335.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby  
30 authorized to execute such purchase contract.

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and  
35 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
36 authorize the purchase of a necessary raman spectroscopy meter for the Mahoning County Type  
37 II Hazmat Team.

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41 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
42 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
43 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
