A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Rigaku Analytical Devices for a raman spectroscopy meter for the Mahoning County Type II Hazmat Team, in an amount not to exceed \$56,335.00, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety, Emergency Management Agency and declaring an emergency.
