A Resolution appropriating funds, in the amount of \$78,924.00, for the County's share of 2019 costs under the Intergovernmental Consolidated Computer Aided Dispatch System Agreement, for the Executive's Department of Finance and Budget, and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, pursuant to Resolution 2018-209, this Council authorized the County Executive to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement for the Acquisition, Installation and Operation of a Consolidated Computer Aided Dispatch System with the City of Akron, City of Cuyahoga Falls, City of Fairlawn, City of Green and City of Stow ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, under said Agreement, Summit County's share of costs for 2019 total \$94,179.00 with an offsetting credit totaling \$15,255.00 for the addition of the University of Akron to the Agreement in 2019; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary, and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate funds, in the amount of \$78,924.00, for the aforementioned Agreement;
