A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for the Cleveland-Massillon Road at Ghent Road Intersection Improvement Project, located in Bath Township, Council District 5 for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$680,000.00 for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer and Bath Township have determined that there is a public need for an intersection improvement at Cleveland-Massillon Road and Ghent Road, including an intersection reconfiguration and installing a continuous right turn lane on Cleveland-Massillon Road (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer estimates the total cost to be \$680,000.00 with the cost to be paid from Transportation Improvement District funds, County Engineer's Office funds, Bath Township funds, and Embassy Parkway Landowner's Association funds

WHEREAS, the Project will be administered by the County Engineer's office, and with all significant expenditures will require separate Council and/or Board of Control approval; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to advertise for bids for the Cleveland-Massillon Road at Ghent Road Intersection Improvement Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for the Cleveland-Massillon Road at Ghent Road Intersection Improvement Project for an estimated cost not to exceed \$680,000.00.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will reduce congestion and increase safety on a heavily traveled road in Summit County.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
