A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any agreements, memorandums of understanding or other documents necessary to participate with the Village of Mogadore in applying for Ohio Public Works Commission funding for the Sunrise Boulevard Replacement/Reconstruction Project, located in the Village of Mogadore, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$75,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvements Program provides financial assistance through State Issue 1 funds administered by the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC") to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore ("Village") is planning to reconstruct infrastructure along Sunrise Boulevard and Warner Street, including the reconstruction and rehabilitation of sanitary sewer lines ("Project") because said lines are a source of high inflow and infiltration of storm or ground water; and

WHEREAS, the Project will replace substantially all of the existing infrastructure along Sunrise Boulevard and Warner Street, including the reconstruction and rehabilitation of approximately 2,800 linear feet of 8" sanitary sewer by cured in place lining along Sunrise Boulevard and Warner Street in the Village, with a total estimated cost of the lining of \$150,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Village intends to submit an application to OPWC for partial funding of the Project through State Issue 1 funds, and if the application is accepted, OPWC would provide \$75,000.00 in the form of a grant (50%); and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated by the County Executive that the local cash match, in the amount of \$75,000, will be paid through the Department of Sanitary Sewer Services Sewer Enterprise Fund,; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to participate in the Project, and to authorize the County Executive to execute any agreements, memorandums of understanding or other documents necessary to participate with the Village in applying for OPWC funding for the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

# **SECTION 1**

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any agreements, memorandums of understanding or other documents with the Village of Mogadore ("Village") and the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC") necessary to participate with the Village in applying for OPWC funding for the Sunrise Boulevard Replacement/Reconstruction Project ("Project"), located in the Village of Mogadore, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$75,000.00.

# **SECTION 2**

The terms of the application to be submitted to OPWC, and associated documents, shall maximize the requested amount of State Issue 1 funds, with the remainder of the cost of the improvements to be borne by the Village and the County through the County Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services Sewer Enterprise Fund, with the County's share being an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00. The expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00 from the Department of Sanitary Services Enterprise Fund as the County's local cash match for the County's portion of the Project is hereby authorized.

# **SECTION 3**

The Clerk of Council is instructed to provide two (2) certified copies of this Resolution to the Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, for submission to the Ohio Public Works Commission with said funding application.

### **SECTION 4**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will immediately allow the County to apply for funds by the 6/30/2019 deadline in order to obtain funds for the construction of the Project.

# **SECTION 5**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 6**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
