An Ordinance amending Section 927.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Authority Over Private Sewer Laterals," to clarify when the County is required to make repairs to a property owner's private sewer lateral, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 927.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Authority Over Private Sewer Laterals," currently authorizes the County to enforce regulations concerning the construction, installation, and use of private sewer laterals, but does not explicitly state when the County is responsible for the repairs of said laterals; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has proposed amending Section 927.01 to determine when the County is required to make necessary repairs to a property owner's private sewer lateral; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to amend Section 927.01 of the Codified Ordinances for the aforementioned reason;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

Section 927.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Authority Over Private Sewer Laterals," is hereby amended as set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

## **SECTION 2**

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately amend Section 927.01 of the Codified Ordinances to detail the County's responsibility to make repairs to a property owner's private sewer lateral.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
