- (3) Work with existing, interested agencies to develop public education programs to increase participation and awareness in assisting communities in implementing best practices.
- (4) Work with the Engineer and appropriate Summit County communities and agencies in developing regional watershed management plans with neighboring Counties and communities.
- (5) Partner with the Engineer and all Summit County communities in storm water management planning to better leverage local resources and develop long-term solutions for the region.

The Storm Water Management Commission, shall consist of the County Executive, the County Engineer and the President of Summit County Council and five (5) other electors of the County. Included in the other electors shall be a representative from the County Mayor's Association and the County Township Association. All agencies, departments, boards, commissions and political subdivisions of the County that have an interest in storm water may serve as ad hoc members of the Commission and shall receive regular updates of its activities. The County Executive, the County Engineer and the Council President may each appoint an alternate to serve in their respective places.

The members of the Storm Water Commission shall be appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by County Council and be persons with experience in storm water management. The term of office of each member of the Storm Water Management Commission shall be two (2) years. The terms shall be staggered so that no term expires within less than two (2) years of the expiration of any other term. A vacancy occurring during a term shall be filled by the County Executive for the unexpired term in the same manner as a regular appointment.

Of the terms of office for the initial appointees, the County Executive, County Engineer and President of County Council shall have no term and shall serve by virtue of their office. Two (2) members, other than a Representative from the County Mayor's Association and the Township Association shall initially be appointed to a one (1) year term and the remaining members shall be appointed to a two (2) year term. The County Executive shall nominate the initial appointees to the Storm Water Management Commission no later than December 15, 2019, and thereafter within thirty (30) days after the occurrence of a vacancy. If County Council fails to accept or reject a nomination within forty-five (45) days of its having been presented to it, the nomination shall be deemed confirmed.

The County Executive may remove any member of the Storm Water Management Commission for inefficiency, neglect of duty or malfeasance in office, after notice and public hearing before County Council, provided that two-thirds of the County Council concur.

SECTION 4

The Clerk of Council shall certify the question set forth herein to the Board of Elections of the County of Summit no later than the ninetieth day prior to the General Election of November 5, 2019.
