A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a renewal (second and final) of a One-Stop Operator Services contract with the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments, pursuant to which the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services will provide One-Stop Operator services at the Ohio Means Jobs Summit County Center, for the period 7/1/19 to 6/30/20, for which the County shall be paid an amount not to exceed \$228,667.53, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Labor's Employment and Training Administration funds a network of American Job Centers ("AJCs") to provide free employment assistance to job seekers at AJC network locations across the United States; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (the "WIOA") Section 121(d)(2)(A), Local Workforce Areas must competitively procure the Operators of AJCs; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to requirements of WIOA, and on the behalf of the Summit/Medina Workforce Development Board (the "WDB"), the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments (the "SAMWA COG"), which serves as the Ohio Workforce Area 2 ("Area 2") staff, completed a competitive process to procure Operators for the Area's AJCs, known in the State of Ohio as Ohio Means Jobs Centers-in Summit County as the Ohio Means Jobs Summit County Center, and in Medina County as the OMJ Medina County Center; and

WHEREAS, on behalf of the WDB, the SAMWA COG awarded a One-Stop Operator Services contract to the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS") to provide One-Stop Operator Services at the Ohio Means Jobs Summit County Center through 6/30/18, with two options to renew for an additional one-year term, and this Council subsequently authorized the County Executive to execute the same pursuant to Resolution No. 2017-347 and a subsequent renewal pursuant to Resolution No. 2018-137; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended that the County enter into a renewal (second and final) of the One-Stop Operator Services contract with the SAMWA COG, pursuant to which DJFS will provide One-Stop Operator Services at the Ohio Means Jobs Summit County Center, for the period 7/1/19 to 6/30/20, for which the County shall be paid an amount not to exceed \$228,667.53; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute a renewal (second and final) of the One-Stop Operator Services contract with the SAMWA COG, pursuant to which DJFS will provide One-Stop Operator services at the Ohio Means Jobs Summit County Center, for the period 7/1/19 to 6/30/20, for which the County shall be paid an amount not to exceed \$228,667.53; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a renewal (second and final) of a One-Stop Operator Services contract with the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments ("SAMWA COG"), pursuant to which the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS") will provide One-Stop Operator services at the Ohio Means Jobs Summit County Center, for the period 7/1/19 to 6/30/20, for which the County shall be paid an amount not to exceed \$228,667.53.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately authorize the Executive to execute a necessary renewal of a One-Stop Operator Services contract with the SAMWA COG, so that DJFS may immediately provide said services at the Ohio Means Jobs Summit County Center effective 7/1/19.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

INTRODUCED
