7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community corrections**
9 **services funded through the Targeted Community Alternatives to Prison grant, for the**
10 **period 7/1/19 through 6/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00, for the**
11 **Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety, and**
12 **declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 29, 2019, awarded a
15 professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community
16 corrections services funded through the Targeted Community Alternatives to Prison grant, for
17 the period 7/1/19 through 6/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00, subject to
18 confirmation by County Council; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. is necessary and in
22 the best interest of the County of Summit;

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24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that:

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,
30 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community corrections services funded through the Targeted
31 Community Alternatives to Prison grant, for the period 7/1/19 through 6/30/21, in an amount not
32 to exceed \$1,000,000.00 is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to
33 execute such professional service contract.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
38 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
39 provide for community corrections services funded through the Targeted Community
40 Alternatives to Prison grant during the grant period.

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42 SECTION 3

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44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.






