7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute intergovernmental agreements**
8 **with Geauga County, Stark County and the City of North Royalton for inmate boarding,**
9 **and to expend funds for that purpose, in a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$80,000.00,**
10 **for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

11
12 WHEREAS, Section 341.12 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the sheriff of a county
13 where there is not adequate jailing capacity or staffing to convey inmates to a jail located in
14 another county; and

15
16 WHEREAS, Section 177.07(a)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
17 exempts from competitive bidding contracts with other governmental entities, including those
18 that would contract with the County to house inmates in their jails; and

19
20 WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the County Executive to execute
21 intergovernmental agreements with Geauga County, Stark County and the City of North
22 Royalton for inmate boarding; and

24 WHEREAS, given the nature of the fluidity of inmate boarding needs and related medical
25 services, it is impossible to ascertain how much the County will ultimately spend with each
26 governmental entity, thereby making it necessary to authorize the County Executive to expend
27 funds for said purposes, in a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$80,000.00; and

29 WHEREAS, this Council hereby finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent
30 information, that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the
31 County Executive to execute intergovernmental agreements with Geauga County, Stark County
32 and the City of North Royalton for inmate boarding, and to expend funds for that purpose, in a
33 total aggregate amount not to exceed \$80,000.00;

35 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State
36 of Ohio, that:

40 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute intergovernmental agreements
41 with Geauga County, Stark County and the City of North Royalton for inmate boarding, and to
42 expend funds for that purpose, in a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$80,000.00.

46 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
47 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
48 allowing the Sheriff to continue boarding inmates in jails in Geauga County, Stark County and
49 the City of North Royalton.
