A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a HOME Investment Partnership Program Agreement with Family and Community Services, Inc. in the total amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 for the Summit Liberty House project, in Council District 4, for the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development receives HOME funds from the Department of US Housing and Urban Development, which are to be used to create affordable housing for low to moderate income individuals; and

WHEREAS, Family and Community Services, Inc. will be rehabilitating a four-unit apartment to provide permanent supportive housing for formerly homeless female veterans with children, known as the Summit Liberty House project, in Council District 4; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to enter into a HOME Investment Partnership Program ("HOME") Agreement with Family and Community Services, Inc. in the total amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 for the Summit Liberty Home project; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute a HOME Investment Partnership Program Agreement with Family and Community Services, Inc. in the total amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 for the Summit Liberty House project;

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a HOME Investment Partnership Program Agreement with Family and Community Services, Inc. for the rehabilitation of a four-unit apartment to provide permanent supportive housing for formerly homeless female veterans with children, known as the Summit Liberty House project, in Council District 4, in the total amount not to exceed \$100,000.00.
