WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 21, 2017, awarded a professional service contract with MS Consultants, Inc. for professional design services for the Upper Tusc. Waste Water Treatment Plant #36 RBC Replacement Project (Q-959), in Council District 8, in an amount not to exceed \$993,978.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 22, 2017, awarded a professional service contract with H.R. Gray, for professional constructability review services for Waste Water Treatment Plant #36 RBC Replacement Project (Q-959), in Council District 8, in an amount not to exceed \$58,940.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 8, 2018, awarded a professional service contract with H.R.Gray, for construction management services related to the Upper Tuscarawas Waste Water Treatment Plant #36 RBC Project (Q-959), in Council District 8, in an amount not to exceed \$1,403,878.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 15, 2018, awarded a construction contract with Kenmore Construction Co., Inc., for the Upper Tuscarawas Waste Water Treatment Plant #36 RBC Project (Q-967) ("Project"), in an amount not to exceed \$17,643,750.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution Numbers. 2017-277, 2017-506, 2018-324 and 2018-323, confirming the award of said contracts, and appropriating funds; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the Executive to execute a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan agreement to fund the Upper Tuscarawas Waste Water Treatment Plant #36 RBC Project (Q-959), in Council District 8, in a total amount not to exceed \$22,182,440.00, to reflect the Project's professional services, construction and contingency costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## **SECTION 1**
