A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award from the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice Services of an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance grant, for the period 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in the amount of \$84,263.08, with a 25% local cash match requirement of \$28,087.70, and appropriating funds in the amount of \$112,350.78, for Fiscal Year 2019, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice Services ("ODPS-OCJS") has awarded the County Sheriff's Office an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance grant, for the period 1/1/19 through 12/31/19 in the amount of \$84,263.08 with a 25% local cash match requirement of \$28,087.70; and

WHEREAS, this Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance grant will fund a countywide drug unit task force which will specifically target the manufacture, distribution and acquisition of illegal drugs in Summit County; and

WHEREAS, the local cash match will be provided by funds from the Sheriff's Summit County Drug Unit checking account; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds in the amount of \$112,350.78; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned Edward Byrne Memorial Justice grant from the ODPS-OCJS, and to appropriate grant funds and the local cash match;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

#### SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept the award by the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice Services ("ODPS-OCJS") of an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance grant, for the period 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in the amount of \$84,263.08, with a 25% local cash match requirement of \$28,087.70.

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance grant from ODPS-OCJS and appropriate funds, so that the same may be used to fund the Sheriff's drug unit task force operations as soon as possible.

## **SECTION 5**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## SECTION 6

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
