A Resolution declaring the replacement of the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge over Wolf Creek, located in Copley Township, in Council District 5, to be an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, authorizing the County Executive to execute any agreements and any other documents necessary for the replacement of the Bridge, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, and authorizing the County Executive to execute any agreements and any other documents necessary to accept emergency grant funding available from the State of Ohio or the Federal Highway Administration for the replacement of said Bridge, for the County Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, during recent repair work to the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge over Wolf Creek (COP-017-1141), located in Copley Township, in Council District 5, the County Engineer's maintenance workers discovered severe deterioration to the exterior bridge beams; and

WHEREAS, further inspection by a Senior Bridge Engineer from E.L. Robinson, Inc. recommended immediate action to narrow the bridge and remove the asphalt as soon as reasonably possible to evaluate the condition of the interior beams; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer's maintenance workers removed the asphalt and discovered cracks in the interior bridge beams; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has determined the damage to the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge a threat to public safety and has closed the bridge to traffic until a replacement can be made; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has begun the process of demolishing the remaining parts of the bridge and contacting construction contractors and culvert pipe manufacturers to get quotes on the cost of demolishing and replacing the current structure; and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary for the County to engage a contractor and possibly an engineering design firm for the replacement of the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge over Wolf Creek; and

WHEREAS, it is critical to replace the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge over Wolf Creek as quickly as possible; and

WHEREAS, emergency grant funding from the State of Ohio or the Federal Highway Administration may be available for the replacement of the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge over Wolf Creek and the County Engineer intends to apply for said funding; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit permits the County Executive to enter into agreements without following the competitive bidding process in times of emergency; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the replacement of the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge over Wolf Creek constitutes an emergency under Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and further finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to execute any agreements and any other documents necessary for the replacement of the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, and to authorize the Executive to execute any agreements and any other documents necessary to apply for and accept grant funding from the State of Ohio and the Federal Highway Administration for said project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

This Council hereby finds and determines that the replacement of the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge over Wolf Creek (COP-017-1141) located in Copley Township, in Council District 5, constitutes an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit.

SECTION 2

The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements and any other documents necessary for the replacement of the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge over Wolf Creek, subject to the approval of the Board of Control. The County Engineer, where time permits, shall obtain three quotes for any work to be performed prior to the submitting an agreement to the Board of Control for approval. The County Executive is further authorized to execute any agreements and any other documents to accept emergency grant funding available from the State of Ohio or the Federal Highway Administration for the replacement of the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge over Wolf Creek.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately allow for the replacement of the Cleveland-Massillon Road Bridge over Wolf Creek.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
