A Resolution declaring it necessary to submit the question of the renewal of an existing tax levy to the electors of the County of Summit for the purpose of mental health and recovery programs for children, adults, and families for the County service district, and for the acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance and operation of the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADM) Board facilities; requesting the Summit County Fiscal Officer to certify the total valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that renewal levy, for the ADM Board, and declaring an emergency.

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WHEREAS, the Council of the County of Summit is the taxing authority of the County pursuant to Article III, Section 3.01 of the County Charter; and

WHEREAS, the electors of this County on November 5, 2013 approved the renewal of a 2.95 mill levy for the purpose of mental health and recovery programs for children, adults, and families for the County service district, and for the acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance and operation of the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADM) Board facilities; and

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for necessary requirements of the aforesaid purpose, and it is necessary to renew the levy of a tax in excess of such limitation pursuant to Section 5705.221 of the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Social Services Advisory Board has recommended and requested that Council place upon the ballot at the election on November 5, 2019, the question of the renewal of that existing levy, being a tax levy of 2.95 mills for the aforesaid purpose, to run for a period of six (6) years, beginning with the 2020 tax list and duplicate, for collection in the years 2021 through 2026 inclusive; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5705.03(B) of the Revised Code, it is necessary for the taxing authority to certify to the County Fiscal Officer a resolution requesting that the County Fiscal Officer certify to the taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of the revenue that would be generated by the aforesaid renewal levy; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to declare the necessity of renewing the aforementioned tax levy of 2.95 mills for the County of Summit ADM Board and to certify this Resolution to the County Fiscal Officer requesting that she certify to the taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the County, and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the aforesaid renewal levy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring, that:

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SECTION 1

It is necessary to renew the existing 2.95 mill tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation for a period of six (6) years, commencing with the 2020 tax list and duplicate for collection in the years 2021 through 2026, inclusive, for the purpose of mental health and recovery programs for children, adults, and families for the County service district, and for the acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance and operation of the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADM) Board facilities.

SECTION 2

In accordance with Section 5705.03(B) of the Revised Code, this Council authorizes and requests the Clerk of Council to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Fiscal Officer for calculation of the total current tax valuation of the County, and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the aforesaid renewal levy of 2.95 mills. This Council requests the County Fiscal Officer to thereupon certify to it both (i) the total current tax valuation of the County, and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the aforesaid renewal levy of 2.95 mills.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to timely certify to the Summit County Board of Elections this ballot issue.

SECTION 4

Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.
