7 **A Resolution declaring it necessary to submit the question of the renewal of an existing tax**
8 **levy to the electors of the County of Summit for the purpose of mental health and recovery**
9 **programs for children, adults, and families for the County service district, and for the**
10 **acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance and operation of the County**
11 **of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADM) Board facilities;**
12 **requesting the Summit County Fiscal Officer to certify the total valuation of the County**
13 **and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that renewal levy, for the**
14 **ADM Board, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the Council of the County of Summit is the taxing authority of the County
17 pursuant to Article III, Section 3.01 of the County Charter; and

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19 WHEREAS, the electors of this County on November 5, 2013 approved the renewal of a
20 2.95 mill levy for the purpose of mental health and recovery programs for children, adults, and
21 families for the County service district, and for the acquisition, construction, renovation,
22 financing, maintenance and operation of the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and
23 Mental Health Services (ADM) Board facilities; and

25 WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will
26 be insufficient to provide for necessary requirements of the aforesaid purpose, and it is necessary
27 to renew the levy of a tax in excess of such limitation pursuant to Section 5705.221 of the
28 Revised Code; and

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30 WHEREAS, the Summit County Social Services Advisory Board has recommended and
31 requested that Council place upon the ballot at the election on November 5, 2019, the question of
32 the renewal of that existing levy, being a tax levy of 2.95 mills for the aforesaid purpose, to run
33 for a period of six (6) years, beginning with the 2020 tax list and duplicate, for collection in the
34 years 2021 through 2026 inclusive; and

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36 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5705.03(B) of the Revised Code, it is necessary for the
37 taxing authority to certify to the County Fiscal Officer a resolution requesting that the County
38 Fiscal Officer certify to the taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the County and the
39 dollar amount of the revenue that would be generated by the aforesaid renewal levy; and

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41 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
42 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to declare the necessity of
43 renewing the aforementioned tax levy of 2.95 mills for the County of Summit ADM Board and
44 to certify this Resolution to the County Fiscal Officer requesting that she certify to the taxing
45 authority the total current tax valuation of the County, and the dollar amount of revenue that
46 would be generated by the aforesaid renewal levy.

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48 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
49 State of Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring, that:
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4 SECTION 1

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6 It is necessary to renew the existing 2.95 mill tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation
7 for a period of six (6) years, commencing with the 2020 tax list and duplicate for collection in
8 the years 2021 through 2026, inclusive, for the purpose of mental health and recovery programs
9 for children, adults, and families for the County service district, and for the acquisition,
10 construction, renovation, financing, maintenance and operation of the County of Summit
11 Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADM) Board facilities.

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13 SECTION 2

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15 In accordance with Section 5705.03(B) of the Revised Code, this Council authorizes and
16 requests the Clerk of Council to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Fiscal Officer for
17 calculation of the total current tax valuation of the County, and the dollar amount of revenue that
18 would be generated by the aforesaid renewal levy of 2.95 mills. This Council requests the
19 County Fiscal Officer to thereupon certify to it both (i) the total current tax valuation of the
20 County, and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the aforesaid renewal
21 levy of 2.95 mills.

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23 SECTION 3

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25 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
26 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to timely certify to
27 the Summit County Board of Elections this ballot issue.

29 SECTION 4

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31 Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
32 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
33 effect and be force at the earliest time provided by law.

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35 SECTION 5

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37 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
38 the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
39 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
40 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
41 121.22 of the Revised Code.
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


