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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for a Raman**  
8 **spectroscopy meter for the Mahoning County Type II Hazardous Materials Response**

10 **of Law and Risk Management Division of Public Safety – Emergency Management Agency**  
11 **and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
14 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for a Raman spectroscopy  
17 meter for the Mahoning County Type II Hazardous Materials Response Team, for an estimated  
18 total cost not to exceed \$60,000.00; and

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20 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council's office;

23 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
24 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
25 advertise for bids for the aforementioned Raman spectroscopy meter for the Mahoning County

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33 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for a Raman spectroscopy meter  
34 for the Mahoning County Type II Hazardous Materials Response Team, for an estimated total  
35 cost not to exceed \$60,000.00.

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37 SECTION 2

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39 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
40 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the  
41 Executive to immediately advertise for the aforementioned necessary equipment for the  
42 Mahoning County Type II Hazardous Materials Response Team in order to provide necessary  
43 equipment to the Team in a timely manner.

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47 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
48 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
49 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


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6 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating


