RESOLUTION NO. 2019-157

A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an award of two Violence Against Women Act grants from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services to support a victim services coordinator, for the periods 1/1/19 through 6/30/19 and 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in the total amount of \$44,999.96, with a total local cash requirement of \$14,999.99, for a grant total of \$59,999.95, and appropriating funds, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services ("OCJS") has awarded a Violence Against Women Act ("VAWA") grant of federal funds to the County Prosecutor, for the period 1/1/19 through 6/30/19, in the amount of \$15,000.00, which requires a local cash match requirement in the amount of \$5,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the OCJS has also awarded a VAWA grant of federal funds to the County Prosecutor, for the period 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in the amount of \$29,999.96, which requires a local cash match requirement in the amount of \$9,999.99; and

WHEREAS, the local cash match for both grants will be provided by funds from the Prosecutor's General Fund; and

WHEREAS, VAWA program funding supports a victim advocate position, in order to provide the mandated services to victims of crime; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grants from OCJS and to appropriate these grant funds and the required local cash matches;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
