7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Tyler Technologies Inc., at Sourcewell pricing, for the purchase of bus GPS's for the City**
9 **of Green Local School District bus fleet, in an amount not to exceed \$119,227.50, for the**
10 **Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 3, 2019, awarded a purchase
13 contract with Tyler Technologies Inc., at Sourcewell pricing, for the purchase of bus GPS's for
14 the City of Green Local School District bus fleet, in an amount not to exceed \$119,227.50,
15 subject to confirmation by County Council; and

17 WHEREAS, said purchase will be funded by a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice
18 Community Oriented Policing Services School Violence Prevention Program Grant previously
19 accepted by the County pursuant to Resolution No. 2018-457; and;

21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
22 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Tyler Technologies Inc. is necessary and in the
23 best interest of the County of Summit;

25 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State
26 of Ohio, that:

30 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Tyler Technologies Inc.,
31 at Sourcewell pricing, for the purchase of bus GPS's for the City of Green Local School District
32 bus fleet, in an amount not to exceed \$119,227.50, is hereby confirmed and the County
33 Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract.

37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
38 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
39 authorize the purchase of necessary bus GPS's for the safety of students using the City of Green
40 School District buses.

44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


