A Resolution raising public awareness of the 2020 Census at the one year out milestone, and affirming the County of Summit's support for the Census, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.
WHEREAS, the U.S. Census Bureau is required by the U.S. Constitution to conduct a count of the population every ten years;
WHEREAS, the upcoming decennial census will begin on Census Day, which is April 1, 2020; and
WHEREAS; the Census is used to determine political representation and federal funding distribution, therefore, ensuring a complete and accurate count of all residents is vital for our community; and
WHEREAS, more than \$675 billion in federal funding flows back to states and local communities each year based on census data, which impacts services and infrastructure including health care, senior centers, jobs, roads, schools, and businesses; and
WHEREAS, the Census Bureau is required by law to keep any personal information collected confidential, and each employee of the Census Bureau takes a lifetime oath to protect all information collected, unable to use it for anything other than to produce statistics; and
WHEREAS, the County of Summit recognizes the equal importance of each resident and is committed to raising awareness and educating all residents of the significance of the 2020 Census, as we strive to achieve a complete and accurate count.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
SECTION 1
The County of Summit supports the goals of the 2020 Census and commits to raising awareness and educating all residents of the importance of the 2020 Census, encouraging participation to ensure a complete and accurate count.
SECTION 2
This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately encouraging the education and awareness of the 2020 Census.
SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take

effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect

and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
