A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to pay an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00, representing the County's self-insured retention, to Tokio Marine Houston Casualty Company, the County's liability insurer, toward the costs of legal representation and services on behalf of the County and Tokio Marine Houston Casualty Company, in <u>Jane Doe v. Summit County</u>, <u>et al.</u>, for the Executive and the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Jane Doe has filed a lawsuit arising out of an alleged incident concerning Lieutenant Antonio Williamson that is alleged to have occurred on March 19, 2017 against the County, the Summit County the Sheriff's Department, Sheriff Steve Barry and Lieutenant Williamson, <u>Jane Doe v. Summit County, et al.</u>, Case No. CV-2019-03-1047, before Kathryn Michael in the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas (the "Lawsuit"); and

WHEREAS, the County's liability insurer, Tokio Marine Houston Casualty Company, has agreed to defend the County and has retained legal counsel, Mazanec, Raskin & Ryder Co., L.P.A., to provide legal representation and services on behalf of the County and Tokio Marine Houston Casualty Company in the Lawsuit; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of its insurance contract with Tokio Marine Houston Casualty Company, the County has a \$75,000.00 self-insured retention on a claims-made basis; and

WHEREAS, in order to have Mazanec, Raskin & Ryder Co., L.P.A., provide legal representation and services on behalf of the County and Tokio Marine Houston Casualty Company in the lawsuit, the County is required to pay the first \$75,000.00 of costs, representing its self-insured retention; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit for the County Executive to pay an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00, to Tokio Marine Houston Casualty Company toward the costs of legal representation and services by legal counsel, Mazanec, Raskin & Ryder Co., L.P.A., on behalf of the County and Tokio Marine Houston Casualty Company in the Lawsuit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
