WHEREAS, the County's insurance broker, Wichert Insurance Services, Inc. dba Wichert Insurance, conducted a search on the County's behalf for liability, boiler and machinery, property insurance coverage and other miscellaneous and necessary insurance coverage for a one-year term, from 4/15/19 through 4/15/20; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Law and Risk Management received a proposal from Wichert Insurance Services, Inc. dba Wichert Insurance for the purchase of contracts for liability. boiler and machinery, property, and other miscellaneous and necessary insurance coverage, for a one-year term, from 4/15/19 through 4/15/20, in an amount not to exceed \$923,431.00, payable through Wichert Insurance Services, Inc. dba Wichert Insurance, as a Best Practical Source; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 13, 2019, authorized the purchase of contracts for liability, boiler and machinery, property, and other miscellaneous and necessary insurance coverage, for a one-year term, from 4/15/19 through 4/15/20, in an amount not to exceed \$923,431.00, payable through Wichert Insurance Services, Inc. dba Wichert Insurance, as a Best Practical Source, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to confirm the award by the Board of Control authorizing the purchase of contracts for liability, boiler and machinery, property, and other miscellaneous and necessary insurance coverage, for a one-year term, from 4/15/19 through 4/15/20, in an amount not to exceed \$923,431.00, payable through Wichert Insurance Services, Inc. dba Wichert Insurance, as a Best Practical Source;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1
