7 **A Resolution adjusting existing appropriations, in the amount of \$5,000.00, for the Turning**  
8 **Point Program, for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, and declaring an**  
9 **emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Amended Resolution 2018-331, which  
12 authorized the County Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the County of  
13 Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board to accept a Specialized  
14 Docket Subsidy, for the period 7/1/18 through 6/30/19, in the amount of \$140,000.00, with no  
15 local cash match requirement, and appropriated funds; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, said appropriations included a Specialized Docket Subsidy, in the amount of  
18 \$50,000.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division's Turning Point Program; and

19  
20 WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust existing appropriations, in the amount of \$5,000.00,  
21 from the Other Expenses account to the Salary Account for the Turning Point Program; and

23 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
24 that the aforementioned adjustment of appropriations is necessary and in the best interest of the  
25 County of Summit;

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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


