An Ordinance amending Section 177.14 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Construction Contracts," to permit the use of construction management-at-risk and design build methods for the construction of County improvements, in addition to the use of general contractors, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, several years ago, the State of Ohio adopted revisions to the Ohio Revised Code allowing agencies of the State and political subdivisions within the State to utilize construction management-at-risk and design-build methods for the construction of public improvements; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio began utilizing and permitting the use of construction management-at-risk and design-build methods for the construction of public improvements because it is consistent with practice in the private sector, enables improvements to be completed in a more timely fashion, and often results in improvements being completed at lower cost than traditional methods; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.14 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Construction Contracts," currently permits the use of general contractors and the procurement of separate prime contractors for County improvements, but does not currently permit the use of the construction management-at-risk method for the construction of County improvements, and only permits the design-build method to be used for certain County improvements undertaken by the County Engineer; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has proposed amending Section 177.14 to permit the use of construction management-at-risk and design build methods for the construction of County improvements, in addition to the use of general contractors; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to amend Section 177.14 to permit the use of construction management-at-risk and design build methods for the construction of County improvements, in addition to the use of general contractors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## **SECTION 1**

Section 177.14 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Construction Contracts," is hereby amended as set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

## **SECTION 2**

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will immediately allow for the use of alternative construction methods that are likely to result in County improvements being undertaken in a more timely fashion and at lower cost.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

ENACTED EFFECTIVE \_\_\_

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
