Summit County Public Health, pursuant to which the County Sheriff's Office will transport unused pharmaceuticals for incineration, for a five year term, in exchange for payment by Summit County Public Health in the amount of \$50.00 per hour, for a total amount not to exceed \$14,400.00 per year, for a total amount not to exceed \$72,000.00, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Sheriff is responsible for delivering collected pharmaceuticals to the Ross Environmental Services incinerator facility in Elyria, Ohio as part of the Summit County pharmaceutical disposed unused medical prescription program ("D.U.M.P. program"); and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Combined General Health District d.b.a. Summit County Public Health has agreed to pay the Sheriff \$50.00 per hour to transport said unused pharmaceuticals, for a total amount not to exceed \$14,400.00 per year, for a total amount not to exceed \$72,000.00 during the five-year term of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the County and Summit County Public Health to enter into an intergovernmental agreement, for a five-year term, to set forth the duties and responsibilities of the parties concerning the transport of unused pharmaceuticals related to the D.U.M.P. program; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute said intergovernmental agreement with Summit County Public Health for the aforementioned reason;
