7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a blanket purchase order**  
8 **with Ports Petroleum Co., Inc., for unleaded and diesel fuel for general fleet operations and**  
9 **standby generators, at State Term pricing, in an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00, for the**  
10 **Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on January 30, 2019 awarded a  
13 blanket purchase order with Ports Petroleum Co., Inc., for unleaded and diesel fuel for general  
14 fleet operations, at State Term pricing, in an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00, subject to  
15 confirmation by County Council; and

17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
18 that the blanket purchase order with Ports Petroleum Co., Inc., for unleaded and diesel fuel for  
19 general fleet operations and standby generators is necessary and in the best interest of the County  
20 of Summit;

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22 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
23 of Ohio, that:

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25 SECTION 1

27 The award by the Board of Control of a blanket purchase order with Ports Petroleum Co.,  
28 Inc., for unleaded and diesel fuel for general fleet operations and standby generators, at State  
29 Term pricing, in an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County  
30 Executive is hereby authorized to execute such blanket purchase order.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and  
35 welfare of the residents of Summit County, and for the further reason to immediately provide  
36 unleaded and diesel fuel for general fleet operations and standby generators.

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38 SECTION 3

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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44 SECTION 4

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46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating  
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
48 deliberations of this council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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
