A Resolution authorizing appropriation proceedings for an easement over the real property known as Permanent Parcel No. 3303665, owned by SEG Commercial, LLC, a California limited liability company, needed for the Indian Creek Exposed Sewers Project (Q-180), located in the City of Macedonia, in Council District 1, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, sanitary sewer easements are needed for the Indian Creek Exposed Sewers Project (Q-180) ("Project"), located in the City of Macedonia, in Council District 1; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit has been unable to acquire the easement necessary for the Project over the real property known as Permanent Parcel No. 3303665 (5E1 & 5E2) because the owner of this parcel, SEG Commercial, LLC, a California limited liability company, has refused or failed to respond to the County's Notice of Intent to Acquire and Good Faith Offer made on or around November 13, 2018, after numerous attempts by the County's agent to obtain a response; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire said right-of-way by court proceedings under the provisions of Section 6117.39 and Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County of Summit hereby declares its intention to appropriate an easement for sanitary sewer purposes over the real property known as Permanent Parcel No. 3303665 (5E1 & 5E2), and described on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten, said property being owned by SEG Commercial, LLC, a California limited liability company, located in the City of Macedonia, in Council District 1.

SECTION 2

The County Prosecutor is hereby directed to prepare and file on behalf of Summit County, Ohio, proceedings for appropriations of said easement, under the provisions of Chapters 6177 and 163 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3

The County Executive, through the County Fiscal Officer, is hereby authorized to draw by voucher upon the County and pay into the Court of Common Pleas at the time costs of the filing of a complaint for the appropriation of an easement on said real property, under the provisions of Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code, in an amount not to exceed \$520.00.
