WHEREAS, the Summit County Combined General Health District d.b.a. Summit County Public Health wishes to have the County Prosecutor provide in-house legal services to Summit County Public Health for a one-year term, from 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in exchange for payment by Summit County Public Health to the Prosecutor, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive, the Prosecutor and Summit County Public Health wish to enter into an intergovernmental legal services contract to set forth the duties and responsibilities of the parties concerning the provision of said in-house legal services by the Prosecutor; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned intergovernmental legal services contract with Summit County Public Health for the aforementioned reasons;

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental legal services contract with the Summit County Combined General Health District d.b.a. Summit County Public Health for the County Prosecutor to provide in-house legal services to Summit County Public Health for a one-year term, from 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in exchange for payment by Summit County Public Health to the Prosecutor, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said intergovernmental legal services contract and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof by the County Executive.
