7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute the first renewal of an**  
8 **intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron for direct indictment services to be**  
9 **provided by the County Prosecutor, for a one-year term, from 1/1/19 through 12/31/19,**  
10 **and appropriating funds received pursuant to the intergovernmental agreement in the**  
11 **amount of \$310,000.00, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-197, which  
14 authorized the County Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the City of  
15 Akron for direct indictment services to be provided by the County Prosecutor, for a one-year  
16 term, from 1/1/18 through 12/31/18, and appropriated funds received pursuant to the  
17 intergovernmental agreement in the amount of \$310,000.00;

19 WHEREAS, the County and the City of Akron wish to enter into the first renewal of the  
20 aforementioned intergovernmental agreement for direct indictment services to be provided by  
21 the County Prosecutor, for a one-year term, from 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, for a total cost to the  
22 City of Akron not to exceed \$310,000.00; and

24 WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the County Executive to execute the  
25 aforementioned first renewal of an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron, and to  
26 appropriate funds received pursuant to said intergovernmental agreement, in the amount of  
27 \$310,000.00; and

29 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all of the pertinent  
30 information, that it is necessary, and in the best interest of this County, to authorize the County  
31 Executive to execute the aforementioned first renewal of an intergovernmental agreement with  
32 the City of Akron for direct indictment services, and to appropriate funds, in the amount of  
33 \$310,000.00, received pursuant to said agreement;

35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit,  
36 State of Ohio, that:

40 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute the first renewal of an  
41 intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron for direct indictment services to be  
42 provided by the County Prosecutor, for a term of one-year, from 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, for a  
43 total cost to the City of Akron not to exceed \$310,000.00.

26 authorize the Executive to execute a necessary renewal of an intergovernmental agreement with  
27 the City of Akron, pursuant to which the Prosecutor will provide direct indictment services to  
28 the City of Akron effective 1/1/19.

32 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
33 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
34 effect, and be in force, at the earliest time provided by law.

39 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all

42 Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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
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
