WHEREAS, the City of Akron ("City") owns certain real property known as the Upper Floor (B1) of the Harold K. Stubbs Justice Center Parking Garage, at 217 S. High St. in the City of Akron, Council District 4, (the "Premises"); and

WHEREAS, the County has been utilizing the Premises without a lease agreement for several years; and
