A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute and deliver a Guaranty Agreement and a Bond Purchase Agreement in connection with the issuance by the Development Finance Authority of Summit County of revenue bonds for the benefit of Akron Community Service Center and Urban League, Inc., and providing for cooperation among the County, the Development Finance Authority of Summit County, the City of Akron and Akron Urban League in refinancing the costs of the Akron Urban League's community service center in the County; for the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Akron Community Service Center and Urban League, Inc. (the "Akron Urban League") has requested the cooperation of the Development Finance Authority of Summit County (the "Authority"), the County and the City of Akron (the "City) to assist with the refinancing of existing obligations previously incurred by the Akron Urban League that paid the costs of the Akron Urban League's community service center located on Vernon Odom Boulevard, and to finance new limited renovations of the same (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, in order to refinance the existing obligations and to finance the new limited renovations, the Authority has agreed to issue its development revenue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$2,750,000 (the "Bonds") and to loan the proceeds of the Bonds to the Akron Urban League; and

WHEREAS, in order to secure and enhance the marketability of the Bonds, the County and the City have each agreed to guaranty payment of one-half of the bond service charges on the Bonds when due and payable by executing and delivering a Guaranty Agreement (the "Guaranty Agreement") among the Authority, the County, the City and the Akron Urban League, which Guaranty Agreement is in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, any payments by the County under the Guaranty Agreement shall be made solely from the County's Nontax Revenues (as defined in the Guaranty Agreement); and

WHEREAS, under the Guaranty Agreement, the Akron Urban League has agreed to repay any amounts paid by the County and the City under the Guaranty Agreement and to secure that repayment obligation, the Akron Urban League shall execute and deliver a mortgage granting a mortgage lien on the Project site in favor of the County and the City, and an assignment of rents assigning all rents to the County and City in the event the County and City make payments under the Guaranty Agreement; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the issuance and sale of the Bonds, the County has determined it is also necessary to execute and deliver a Bond Purchase Agreement (the "Bond Purchase Agreement") between the Authority and the County, which Bond Purchase Agreement shall be in the form attached hereto as Exhibit B.

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to execute and deliver the Guaranty Agreement and the Bond Purchase Agreement in connection with the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

This Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to execute and deliver the Guaranty Agreement in connection with the issuance of the Bonds, which Guaranty Agreement shall be in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, with such revisions and modifications as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of the Guaranty Agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by execution thereof by the County Executive.

## SECTION 2

This Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to execute and deliver the Bond Purchase Agreement in connection with the issuance of the Bonds, which Bond Purchase Agreement shall be in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit B, with such revisions and modifications as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of the Bond Purchase Agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by execution thereof by the County Executive.

## **SECTION 3**

This Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to execute any necessary documents and take all other actions necessary to consummate the transactions contemplated by this Resolution, the Guaranty Agreement and the Bond Purchase Agreement.

## **SECTION 4**

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a professional services agreement with Roetzel and Andress, LPA to provide necessary legal services in connection with the aforementioned transactions on behalf of the County and the City, in an amount not to exceed \$45,000.00, and to further execute any documents necessary to provide for the City's payment of one-half of the cost of said legal fees.

## **SECTION 5**

This resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the County, and for the further reason that the issuance of the Bonds for the benefit of the Akron Urban League is in furtherance of the purposes of the County and is immediately necessary for the continued and ongoing operation of the Project.
