A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, a purchase contract with American Resource Recovery Services Corporation, as a Best Practical Source, for the installation of three re-manufactured rotating biological contactors at the Upper Tusc. WWTP#36, in an amount not to exceed \$163,378.35, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Executive desires to execute a purchase contract with American Resource Recovery Services Corporation, as a Best Practical Source, for the installation of three re-manufactured rotating biological contactors ("RBCs") at the Upper Tusc. WWTP#36, in an amount not to exceed \$163,378.35, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, the authorization of the County Executive to execute the aforementioned purchase contract is subject to the approval of the Board of Control, prior to, or subsequent to, the adoption of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned purchase contract with American Resource Recovery Services Corporation is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

DECOLUTIONA

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, a purchase contract with American Resource Recovery Services Corporation, as a Best Practical Source, for the installation of three re-manufactured rotating biological contactors ("RBCs") at the Upper Tusc. WWTP#36, in an amount not to exceed \$163,378.35.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for the installation of the three re-manufactured RBC's at the Upper Tusc. WWTP#36, so that the plant remains in compliance with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's permitting regulatory requirements.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
