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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Republic Services of Ohio Hauling, LLC, for the disposal of wastewater sludge and**
9 **collection system debris, in an amount not to exceed \$374,400.00, for the Executive's**
10 **Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held January 23, 2019, awarded a
13 purchase contract to Republic Services of Ohio Hauling, LLC, for the disposal of wastewater
14 sludge and collection system debris, as lowest responsive and responsible bidder, in an amount
15 not to exceed \$374,400.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
18 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Republic Services of Ohio Hauling, LLC is
19 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

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24 SECTION 1

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26 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract to Republic Services of Ohio
27 Hauling, LLC, for the disposal of wastewater sludge and collection system debris, in an amount
28 not to exceed \$374,400.00 is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to
29 execute such purchase contract.

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31 SECTION 2

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33 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and
34 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
35 provide for the disposal of wastewater sludge and collection system debris for the Executive's
36 Department of Sanitary Sewer Services.

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38 SECTION 3

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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44 SECTION 4

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46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
