A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for the installation of a standby generator at the North River Road pump station #53, located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$350,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the installation of a standby generator at the North River Road pump station #53 hereinafter referred to as the "Project"), located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$350,000.00, whereby the County will construct a new standby generator to maintain operations at the pump station so that functionality is not disrupted if an electric power failure occurs; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit requires this Council's authorization for the County to advertise for bids for construction contracts in excess of \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the plans and specifications for the Project are on file with the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, the County's Sanitary Sewer Enterprise fund will fund the Project; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary, and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to advertise for bids for the construction of the aforementioned Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$350,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the installation of a standby generator at the North River Road pump station #53 (the "Project"), located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$350,000.00.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately advertise for bids for the construction of the Project so that it may proceed in a timely manner.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
