A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a one-year policing contract with the County of Summit Developmental Disabilities Board, for the period 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in exchange for payment by the Board of \$235,658.85, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Developmental Disabilities Board ("DD Board") wishes to enter into a one-year policing contract with the County of Summit to provide two County Sheriff's Deputies and two one-third shifts of a vehicle, for the period 1/1/19 through 12/31/19; and

WHEREAS, the DD Board has agreed to pay the County the amount of \$19,638.24 per month, for a total of \$235,658.85, for the period 1/1/19 through 12/31/19; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned policing contract with the DD Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a one-year policing contract with the County of Summit Developmental Disabilities Board ("DD Board"), to provide two Sheriff's Deputies and two one-third shifts of a vehicle, for the period 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in exchange for payment by the DD Board of \$19,638.24 per month, for a total amount of \$235,658.85 for the one-year term of the policing contract.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately providing necessary policing to County of Summit Developmental Disabilities Board effective 1/1/19.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
