7 **An Amended Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the**
8 **County of Summit, entitled “Temporary Hiring Freeze,” to authorize the County Sheriff to**
9 **hire a up to 10 new ~~Full-Time~~ Communication Technician I’s, for the Sheriff, and declaring**
10 **an emergency.**

11
12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2020-095, which enacted
13 Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, “Temporary
14 Hiring Freeze,” due to the anticipated economic crisis and related budgetary concerns resulting
15 from the COVID-19 pandemic and the State of Ohio's Stay at Home Order; and

16
17 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(i) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that
18 the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and
19 continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire
20 said employee; and

21
22 WHEREAS, a current Full Time Communication Technician I for the County’s dispatch
23 center has left County employment and a position is vacant; and

24
25 WHEREAS, funding for the position of Communication Technician I will come entirely
26 from Coronavirus Relief Funds for the remainder of 2020; and

27
28 WHEREAS, because of the critical functions of this position, the Sheriff’s Office needs
29 to be able to hire and train a up to 10 replacements;

30
31 WHEREAS, in order for the County’s dispatch center to function properly, it is necessary
32 for the County Sheriff to ~~fill~~ provide for the duties of the position; and

33
34 WHEREAS, this Council has determined, by reviewing all pertinent information, that it
35 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Sheriff to
36 hire a up to 10 new ~~Full-Time~~ Communication Technician I’s;

38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
39 State of Ohio, that:

43 County Council hereby determines that the County Sheriff has demonstrated that it is
44 necessary for the effective and continued operation of the County Sheriff’s Office to authorize,
45 the County Sheriff, pursuant to Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances, to hire a up to 10
46 ~~Full-Time~~ Communication Technician I’s to be funded from Coronavirus Relief Funds for the
47 remainder of 2020.

7 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
8 authorize the County Sheriff to hire a up to 10 new ~~Full-Time~~ Communication Technician I's to
9 allow the efficient operation of the County's dispatch center.

13 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
14 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
15 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

20 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
21 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,


