7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 2 to a**  
8 **professional service contract with Davey Resource Group for Assessed Subdivisions,**  
9 **District 1 Evaluation, Planning and Vegetative Control Services, in Council Districts 1, 4,**  
10 **and 5, in an amount not to exceed \$18,680.00 (a cumulative increase of 132.67%), for a**  
11 **total contract amount not to exceed \$111,680.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an**  
12 **emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, Davey Resource Group was hired in 2019 pursuant to Board of Control  
15 Directive No. 014-19 to evaluate the drainage systems in assessed subdivisions in Subdivision  
16 District 1 (northern Summit County townships, including Bath Township), for an amount not to  
17 exceed \$48,000.00; and

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19 WHEREAS, after evaluating the drainage in assessed subdivisions in District 1, Davey  
20 Resource Group was authorized by Change Order No.1 to perform work consisting of removing  
21 vegetation at the following retention/detention ponds: Ashford Glen A, B, and C, Bradford Oaks  
22 B, Charbonneau A, Estates of Bath F, Four Seasons of Bath A, King's Forest A, Red Hawk  
23 Reserve A, Reserve at Kensington A & B, royal Meadows A, and Southridge Estates A, for an  
24 amount not to exceed \$45,000.00 (for a cumulative increase of 93.75%); and

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26 WHEREAS, County Council adopted Resolution No. 2019-427, which confirmed the  
27 award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1; and

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29 WHEREAS, the County Engineer proposes entering into Change Order 2, which would  
30 authorize Davey Resource Group to dredge the Reserve at Kensington Basin "B" and place rip-  
31 rap at outlet pipes to prevent erosion; and

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33 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its May 27, 2020 meeting, awarded Change Order  
34 No. 2 to the professional service contract with Davey Resource Group for Assessed Subdivisions  
35 District 1 Evaluation, Planning and Vegetative Control Services, in Council Districts 1, 4, and 5,  
36 in an amount not to exceed \$18,680.00 (a cumulative increase of 132.67%), for a total contract  
37 amount not to exceed \$111,680.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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39 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
40 that the aforementioned Change Order No. 2 to the professional service contract with Davey  
41 Resource Group is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
44 of Ohio, that:

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48 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 2 to a professional service  
49 contract with the Davey Resource Group for Assessed Subdivisions District 1 Evaluation,  
50 Planning and Vegetative Control Services, in Council Districts 1, 4, and 5, in an amount not to  
51 exceed \$18,680.00 (a cumulative increase of 132.67%), for a total contract amount not to exceed  
52 \$111,680.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said

8 SECTION 2

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10 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
11 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately  
12 provides for necessary Evaluation, Planning and Vegetative Control Services for Assessed  
13 Subdivisions in Council Districts 1, 4, and 5.

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15 SECTION 3

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17 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
18 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
19 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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21 SECTION 4

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23 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
24 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
25 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
26 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
27 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


