SECTION 2

The terms of the application to be submitted to OPWC, and associated documents, shall maximize the requested amount of State Issue 1 funds, with the remainder of the cost of the improvements to be borne by the Village and the County through the County Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services Sewer Enterprise Fund, with the County's share being an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00. The expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00 from the Department of Sanitary Services Enterprise Fund as the County's local cash match for the County's portion of the Project is hereby authorized.

SECTION 3

The Clerk of Council is instructed to provide two (2) certified copies of this Resolution to the Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, for submission to the Ohio Public Works Commission with said funding application.

SECTION 4

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will immediately allow the County to apply for funds by the 6/30/2020 deadline in order to obtain funds for the construction of the Project.
