7 **A Resolution declaring that the obsolescence of the County Sheriff's Self-Contained**
8 **Breathing Apparatus equipment used to assist the Akron Fire Department at the County**
9 **Jail or County Courthouse is an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified**
10 **Ordinances, and confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
11 **Municipal Emergency Services, Inc. dba Warren Fire Equipment for the purchase of new**
12 **Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus equipment, in an amount not to exceed \$52,464.07,**
13 **for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

14
15 WHEREAS, County Sheriff's Deputies may be called upon to assist the Akron Fire
16 Department with a fire emergency at the County Jail or County Courthouse; and

17
18 WHEREAS, the current Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus that would be used by the
19 Deputies in such a fire emergency are past their life expectancy and can no longer be serviced;

20
21 WHEREAS, the Sheriff recommends that, due to the obsolescence of said equipment, the
22 County enter into a purchase contract with Municipal Emergency Services, Inc. dba Warren Fire
23 Equipment for the purchase of new Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus equipment, in an
24 amount not to exceed \$52,646.07; and

26 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on May 27, 2020, awarded a
27 purchase contract with Municipal Emergency Services, Inc. dba Warren Fire Equipment for the
28 purchase of new Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus equipment, in an amount not to exceed
29 \$52,464.07, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
32 the obsolescence of the County Sheriff's Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus equipment used to
33 assist the Akron Fire Department with a fire at the County Jail or County Courthouse is an
34 emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances, and confirming an
35 award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Municipal Emergency Services, Inc.
36 dba Warren Fire Equipment for the purchase of new Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus
37 equipment, in an amount not to exceed \$52,464.07;

39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

44 This Council finds and determines that the obsolescence of the County Sheriff's Self-
45 Contained Breathing Apparatus equipment used to assist the Akron Fire Department with a fire

47 Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit.

6 Apparatus equipment, in an amount not to exceed \$52,464.07, is hereby confirmed and the
7 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract and any other
8 necessary related documents.

12 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
13 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
14 authorize the purchase of new Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus equipment to replace the
15 current obsolescent equipment.

17 SECTION 4

19 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
20 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
21 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

25 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
26 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
27 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
