7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second of three)**  
8 **of a purchase contract with Callos Resource LLC and/or its subsidiary, American Payroll**  
9 **Service LLC, for payroll services for the period 7/1/20 through 6/30/21, for various youth**  
10 **employment programs, including summer youth and year round programs, in an amount**  
11 **not to exceed \$1,150,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services,**  
12 **and declaring an emergency.**

13  
14 WHEREAS, County Council adopted Resolution No. 2018-151, which confirmed the  
15 award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Callos Resource LLC and/or its  
16 subsidiary, American Payroll Service LLC ("Callos"), for payroll services for the period 5/1/18  
17 through 6/30/19, for various youth employment programs, including summer youth and year  
18 round programs, in an amount not to exceed \$2,220,568.19; and

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20 WHEREAS, the bid provided by Callos Resource LLC and/or its subsidiary, American  
21 Payroll Service LLC included three options to renew for additional one year periods and the  
22 County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS") seeks to renew its  
23 agreement with Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments ("SAMWA  
24 COG") and Callos to provide the aforementioned payroll services; and

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26 WHEREAS, by having one payroll service provider, the burden of meeting payroll and  
27 carrying workers' compensation coverage is alleviated for non-profits and employer sites for  
28 these temporary employees; and

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30 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio recognizes this method as a cost effective manner to  
31 handle issuance of pay (youth wage subsidies) and workers' compensation liability; and

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33 WHEREAS, under this agreement, DJFS and SAMWA COG act as "grantors" of  
34 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act ("WIOA") and Temporary Assistance to Needy  
35 Families ("TANF") funding for the provision of these services; and

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37 WHEREAS, the overall cost of said payroll services for 2020-2021 is reduced because  
38 the COVID-19 pandemic has reduced the expected number of youth served from 1,000 to 500,  
39 which will be served virtually; and

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41 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 27, 2020, awarded a renewal  
42 (second of three) of a purchase contract to Callos for payroll services for the period 7/1/20  
43 through 6/30/21, for various youth employment programs, including summer youth and year  
44 round programs, in an amount not to exceed \$1,150,000.00, subject to confirmation by County  
45 Council; and

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47 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
48 that the renewal (second of three) of the aforementioned purchase contract with Callos is  
49 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

4 SECTION 1

6 The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second of three) of a purchase contract  
7 with Callos for payroll services for the period 7/1/20 through 6/30/21, for various youth  
8 employment programs, including summer youth and year round programs, in an amount not to  
9 exceed \$1,150,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to  
10 execute the purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

12 SECTION 2

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and  
15 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary to  
16 immediately provide required payroll services for various youth employment programs.

18 SECTION 3

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20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

24 SECTION 4

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26 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
27 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
28 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
29 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including  
30 Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


