7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for various types of**  
8 **cleaning supplies and Personal Protective Equipment to respond the COVID-19 pandemic,**  
9 **for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$5,612,000.00 for the Executive's Department of**  
10 **Law and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety/Emergency Management Agency,**  
11 **and declaring an emergency.**

12  
13 WHEREAS, various types of Personal Protective Equipment ("PPE") and cleaning  
14 equipment are required to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

15  
16 WHEREAS, the County of Summit is in the process of creating a county-wide  
17 distribution center in order to leverage purchasing power to assist in procuring various cleaning  
18 supplies and PPE for government and first responder agencies in order to maintain safe, clean  
19 working environments, in accordance with the regulations of the Center for Disease Control and  
20 the Summit County Combined General Health District dba Summit County Public Health; and

21  
22 WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends that County obtain the following types  
23 of PPE and cleaning supplies: (1) Hand sanitizer pumps; (2) Hand sanitizer gallon refills; (3)  
24 Disinfectant solution; (4) Disinfectant wipes; (5) Disposable gloves; (6) Disposable masks; (7)  
25 N95 masks; (8) Reusable cloth masks; (9) Face shields; (10) Safety goggles; (11) Thermometers;  
26 and (12) Isolation gowns, for an estimated total amount not to exceed \$5,612,000.00; and

28 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
29 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

30  
31 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the aforementioned  
32 PPE, for an estimated total amount not to exceed \$5,612,000.00; and

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34 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council's Office;  
35 and

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37 WHEREAS, federal CARES Act funding will provide monies to pay for said purchases;

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40 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
41 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
42 advertise for bids for the aforementioned PPE, for an estimated total cost not to exceed  
43 \$5,612,000.00;

50 Personal Protective Equipment ("PPE") in the following estimated amounts:



38 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.  
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
