7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit, entitled “Temporary Hiring Freeze,” to authorize the Prosecutor to hire one new**
9 **Assistant Prosecuting Attorney 1 in the Child Protective Unit, for the Prosecutor, and**
10 **declaring an emergency.**

11
12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2020-095, which enacted
13 Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, “Temporary
14 Hiring Freeze,” due to the anticipated economic crisis and related budgetary concerns resulting
15 from the COVID-19 pandemic and the State of Ohio's Stay at Home Order; and

16
17 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(i) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that
18 the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and
19 continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire
20 said employees; and

22 WHEREAS, a current full-time Assistant Prosecuting Attorney 1 in the Child Protective
23 Unit for the Prosecutor’s Office is on leave and the position is temporarily vacant; and

25 WHEREAS, because of the critical functions of said position, it is necessary for the
26 County Prosecutor to hire a replacement; and

28 WHEREAS, because the position is in the Child Protective Unit, it is federally
29 reimbursable; and

31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
32 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
33 Prosecutor to hire one new Assistant Prosecuting Attorney 1 in the Child Protective Unit;

35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
36 State of Ohio, that:

40 County Council hereby determines that the County Prosecutor has demonstrated that it is
41 necessary for the effective and continued operation of her office to authorize her, pursuant to
42 Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances, to hire one new Assistant Prosecuting Attorney 1
43 in the Child Protective Unit.

47 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
48 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
49 authorize the County Prosecutor to hire one new Assistant Prosecuting Attorney 1 in the Child
50 Protective Unit.
