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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept the award from the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice**  
9 **Services, of a Drug Law Enforcement Fund grant, in the amount of \$249,992.22, with a**  
10 **25% local cash match requirement of \$83,330.74, for a project total of \$333,322.96, for the**  
11 **period 7/1/20 through 6/30/21, for the County Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice Services,  
14 ("ODPS-OCJS") has awarded the Summit County Sheriff's Office a Drug Law Enforcement  
15 Fund ("DLEF") grant in the amount of \$249,992.22, with a 25% local cash match requirement of  
16 \$83,330.74, for a project total of \$333,322.96, for the period 7/1/20 through 6/30/21 and

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18 WHEREAS, the DLEF grant will fund a countywide drug unit task force which will  
19 specifically target the manufacture, distribution and acquisition of illegal drugs in Summit  
20 County; and

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22 WHEREAS, the local cash match will be provided by funds from the Summit County  
23 Sheriff's Office's Summit County Drug Unit checking account; and

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25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
26 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County  
27 Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned DLEF  
28 grant from the ODPS-OCJS;

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30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
31 of Ohio, that:

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33 SECTION 1

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35 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
36 the award by the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice Services  
37 ("ODPS-OCJS") of a Drug Law Enforcement Fund ("DLEF") grant in the amount of  
38 \$249,992.22, with a 25% local cash match requirement of \$83,330.74, for a project total of  
39 \$333,322.96, for the period 7/1/20 through 6/30/21.

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41 SECTION 2

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43 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
44 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately allow  
45 the DLEF grant funds from ODFS-OCTS to be used by the countywide drug unit task force to  
46 address the problem of illegal drugs in Summit County.

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50 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
51 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise, it shall  
52 take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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


