SCDJFS will complete initial screening and eligibility on application to determine funding stream

United Way will finalize outstanding amounts, work with landlords and issue payment for delinquent rent amounts

SCDJFS will send out client notifications and reimburse United Way for rent paid based on funding source

Homeless applicants will be identified, triaged and routed to existing TANF homeless prevention contract providers (if applicable)

Community partners will be asked to share summitcountycares.org as the source of information and application for these services SCDJFS will identify any individual that indicates that eviction process has been started to fast track them through process and engage Fair Housing & Legal Aid as necessary

SCDJFS will identify any individual with mortgages and batch those applications to the Financial Empowerment Center for case management, forbearance counseling, and payment.

Any applicant with income exceeding 300% FPL will not be initially denied but application will be held for available funding review after all applications with households under 300% FPL have been evaluated
