7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 177.13 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit, authorizing purchases by the County Executive Krumroy-Cozad Construction**
9 **Corporation, as a Best Practical Source, for labor and materials to fabricate and install**
10 **acrylic screens in County offices, in a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$200,000.00,**
11 **and declaring such expenditure of funds and the undertaking of this project necessary due**
12 **to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19),**
13 **for the Executive's Department of Administrative Services-Physical Plants, and declaring**
14 **an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic is a health crisis that requires the different County
17 offices to operate differently; and

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19 WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has also created the need for investments by the
20 County in previously unplanned capital projects that will protect the public and County
21 employees through the installation of plexiglass in County offices; and

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23 WHEREAS, Section 177.13 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
24 requires that purchases by an officeholder exceeding \$50,000.00 in the aggregate in any calendar
25 year, where no additional competitive quotes or bids have been taken, shall be made only upon
26 authorization of County Council; and

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28 WHEREAS, the County Executive anticipates making purchases from Krumroy-Cozad
29 Construction Corporation for labor and materials to fabricate and install acrylic screens in
30 County offices during calendar year 2020, and requests that she be authorized to make said
31 purchases as a Best Practical Source, in a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$200,000.00, in
32 order to protect the public and County employees; and

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34 WHEREAS, Krumroy-Cozad Construction Corporation has been deemed a Best Practical
35 Sources based on their available supply of plexiglass which was procured for a large project that
36 was subsequently cancelled; and

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38 WHEREAS, the Board of Control has previously approved purchases by the County
39 Executive from Krumroy-Cozad Construction Corporation for labor and materials to fabricate
40 and install acrylic screens in County offices, in calendar year 2020, in a total aggregate amount
41 less than \$50,000.00; and

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43 WHEREAS, it is further necessary for this Council to declare said expenditure of funds
44 for the aforementioned purchases from Krumroy-Cozad Construction Corporation and to declare
45 the undertaking of this project necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to
46 COVID-19; and

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48 WHEREAS, federal CARES Act funding will provide monies to pay for said expenses;
49 and

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51 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
52 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize purchases by the County

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4 Executive from Krumroy-Cozad Construction Corporation, as a Best Practical Source, for labor
5 and materials to fabricate and install acrylic screens in County offices in calendar year 2020, in a
6 total aggregate amount not to exceed \$200,000.00;

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8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
9 of Ohio, that;

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11 SECTION 1

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13 Pursuant to Section 177.13 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, this
14 Council hereby authorizes purchases by the County Executive from Krumroy-Cozad
15 Construction Corporation, as a Best Practical Source, for labor and materials to fabricate and
16 install acrylic screens in County offices in calendar year 2020, in a total aggregate amount not to
17 exceed \$200,000.00.

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19 SECTION 2

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21 This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of funds for purchases from
22 Krumroy-Cozad Construction Corporation for labor and materials to fabricate and install acrylic
23 screens in County offices and the undertaking of the project is necessary due to the public health
24 emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the
25 provisions of section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act.

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27 SECTION 3

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29 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
30 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
31 authorizes necessary purchases for labor and materials to fabricate and install acrylic screens that
32 will protect the public and County employees during the public health emergency with respect to
33 the COVID-19 pandemic.

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35 SECTION 4

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37 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
38 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
39 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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41 SECTION 5

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43 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
44 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
45 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
46 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
47 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
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
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
