7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement**  
8 **with the City of Akron for providing unleaded fuel and diesel fuel for County vehicles, for**  
9 **a five-year term, from 1/1/20 through 12/31/24, in the amount of \$.13 per gallon over the**  
10 **City of Akron's wholesale cost, for an approximate cost of \$1,300,000.00 for the term of the**  
11 **agreement, for the County Executive's Department of Finance and Budget, and declaring**  
12 **an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, County Council previously approved Resolution No. 2015-304, which  
15 confirmed an award by the Board of Control of an intergovernmental agreement with the City of  
16 Akron for providing unleaded fuel and diesel fuel for County vehicles, for a five-year term, from  
17 1/1/15 through 12/31/19, in the amount of \$.08 per gallon over the City of Akron's wholesale  
18 cost, for an approximate cost of \$400,979.72 per year based upon 2014 figures; and

20 WHEREAS, the County and Akron have agreed to a new intergovernmental agreement,  
21 pursuant to which Akron will provide unleaded fuel and diesel fuel for County vehicles, for the  
22 period 1/1/20 through 12/31/24, in the amount of \$.13 per gallon over the City of Akron's  
23 wholesale cost, for an approximate cost of \$1,300,000.00 for the term of the agreement; and

25 WHEREAS, the intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron is exempt from  
26 competitive bidding as a contract with another governmental unit pursuant to Section  
27 177.07(a)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit; and

29 WHEREAS, County Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent  
30 information, that the aforementioned intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron is  
31 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
34 of Ohio, that:

36 SECTION 1

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38 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement  
39 and any other necessary related documents with the City of Akron for providing unleaded fuel  
40 and diesel fuel for County vehicles, for a five-year term, from 1/1/20 through 12/31/24, in the  
41 amount of \$.13 per gallon over the City of Akron's wholesale cost, for an approximate cost of  
42 \$1,300,000.00 for the term of the agreement.

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46 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
47 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose of immediately  
48 authorizing the County Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement and any other  
49 necessary related documents with Akron to provide fuel for County vehicles.


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12 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
